Psalm and Gospel acclamation are sometimes sung, please check if unsure. Sometimes there are alternatives for Gospel Acclamations: please use the one printed on the mass sheet (event if it is wrong!).

When there are two readers, one reader reads First Reading and Psalm. The other reader reads Second Reading, Gospel Acclamation and, if there is no Deacon, the Bidding Prayers. If you are reading the Bidding Prayers please approach the lectern at the end of the Creed, so that you are already in place before the priest begins the introduction to the Prayers.

Each time, the two readers should swap roles, but can arrange otherwise.

If only one reader is named, he/she reads everything.
